Post Retirement

Admiral Smith retired from the US Navy on 1 Oct 1996. He served as a "Distinguished Fellow" at the Center for Naval Analysis, was President of Leighton Smith Associates and Vice President of Global Perspectives, Inc., both international consulting firms. He has served on the Boards of several major Corporations and was Chairman of both the US Naval Academy Alumni Association Board of Trustees and the Board of Trustees of the Naval Aviation Museum Foundation. In 2004, he was appointed by President George W. Bush to the US Naval Academy Board f Visitors. He was named "Tailhooker of the Year" in 1997 and, in 2007, was selected as a "Distinguished Graduate of the US Naval Academy.
